Position for Nomination	Diocesan Committee Responsibilities
<p>Standing Committee Seeking one clergy member for four-year term and one lay member for four-year term</p>	<p>The Standing Committee usually meets monthly on Thursday at 9:00 am, at St. Paul, Salem. The Standing Committee advises the Bishop and gives consent in matters of the disposition of property, ecclesiastical discipline, the election and consecration of Bishops, and in the matter of candidates for ordained ministry.</p>
<p>Board of Trustees Seeking one clergy member for three-year term and one lay member for three-year term</p>	<p>The Board of Trustees meets the last Thursday of the month at the Diocesan Offices in Portland at 2:00 pm. The trustees act within bounds set by the Bishop, the Convention, and the Standing Committee to steward the funds and property entrusted to the diocese. The Finance Committee of the Diocese, appointed by the Board of Trustees, conducts ongoing review of all financial transactions in the diocese.</p>
<p>Diocesan Council Seeking two clergy members for three-year term and two lay members for three-year term</p>	<p>The Diocesan Council meets monthly except for November and December. The meetings are usually on Fridays at 9:30 am and ending around 2:00 pm. Most meetings are held at St. Paul, Salem with perhaps one or two meetings at a different location. There is usually an annual overnight orientation at the beginning of the year. Diocesan Council oversees the creation of a budget each year to carry out this work and has authority to create and prescribe the duties of program ministries and committees in support of the mission of the Church in the Diocese.</p>
<p>Oregon Episcopal School Board of Trustees Seeking three people for three-year term</p>	<p>As provided by the Canons, three (3) Trustees of Oregon Episcopal School are elected annually during Diocesan Convention. The slate is filled by the OES Committee on Trustees. Suggestions on nominees are welcomed from congregations. Those elected in October 2010 will begin a three-year term on July 1, 2011. Trustees support the mission statement of OES. They are responsible for the fiduciary health of the school, for developing policies that guide OES, for being knowledgeable of life on the campus and for making an annual financial commitment. The board meets monthly and all Trustees are expected to serve on two committees.</p>
<p>Trinity Cathedral Chapter Seeking one person for a three-year term</p>	<p>Each year the Convention elects a person from the diocese to serve on the Chapter of Trinity Cathedral in Portland. The terms are for three years. The Chapter meets quarterly (with the Cathedral Executive Committee meeting monthly) to transact the business of the Chapter, to set policy regarding use of the Cathedral, to establish the budget for Trinity and to ascertain ways in which the Cathedral congregations and other congregations of the diocese may relate in positive and helpful ways. Diocesan members of the Chapter are also asked to attend the annual Chapter retreat and to assist in the planning and development of the ministry of Trinity.</p>
<p>General Convention Deputies Seeking four clergy deputies, four lay deputies, four clergy alternates and four lay alternates</p>	<p>General Convention meets July 5 – 12, 2012 in Indianapolis, Indiana. All deputies plus the first alternate attend. There are several meetings to go over the distributed convention materials and deputies and alternates are encouraged to visit congregations and convocations to discuss the issues of the convention.</p>
